You must possess a state-issued handicapped sticker or license plate in addition to the Pass you receive from Temple Sholom to park in the lot. There is a very limited number of spaces available in the Temple parking lot.

To reserve a spot, please fill out the information below and return this form postmarked by September 11. You will receive a parking pass in the mail. Please place it visibly in your car window when using the lot for High Holy Day Services.
